

# THE SOUTHERN CAR CLUB JENNIE DYMOND GO-KARTING CHAMPIONSHIP



We are excited to announce a Go-Kart Championship allowing all SCC members to compete against each other in purest form of Motorsport. The Championship will be held across 4 rounds, featuring indoor and outdoor racing in order to crown a winner for whom there will be a prize! This is a great chance for all members young and old to try their hand behind the wheel and compete for some silverware - no licence or equipment required. We look forward to seeing you on the grid!

1. The SCC Go-Karting Championship will be contested over 4 rounds in the year. Rounds may include short practice sessions, but each round will consist of only one points qualifying session - usually the last session completed of the day.
2. The championship calendar will be published on the [southerncarclub.com](http://southerncarclub.com) website.
3. Attendance at any of the 4 rounds will automatically enter the competitor into the Championship.
4. After each round points will be automatically collected and uploaded to the SCC Website. Points will be awarded as follows:

1 <sup>st</sup>	25 points
2 <sup>nd</sup>	20
3 <sup>rd</sup>	16
4 <sup>th</sup>	13
5 <sup>th</sup>	11
6 <sup>th</sup>	9
7 <sup>th</sup>	7
8 <sup>th</sup>	5
9 <sup>th</sup>	3
10 <sup>th</sup>	1
>10 <sup>th</sup> or DNF	0

5. If the points qualifying session is in "race" format rather than "fastest lap" , the competitor who achieves the fastest lap of the points qualifying race session will receive 1 point to their total.
6. The winner of the Championship will be the competitor with the most points after 4 rounds. In the event of a points tie, the winner will be decided by these means:
  1. Most points qualifying session wins
  2. Most second-place finishes
  3. Best finishing position in the final round
7. The Championship winner will be recognised at the Southern Car Club Awards Evening and shall receive the Jennie Dymond trophy.
